RESTRAINING ORDER

Parties to domestic relation actions are subject to the Order from the date of filing suit or service of summons. This Order will be strictly complied with under penalty of Contempt of Court.

1. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from causing or permitting the minor child(ren) of the parties to be removed from the jurisdiction of the Court.
2. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from doing, or attempting to do, or threatening to do any act of injuring, maltreating, vilifying, molesting, or harassing the adverse party or any of the child(ren) or the parties.
3. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from selling, encumbering, contracting to sell, or otherwise disposing of or removing from the jurisdiction of this court, any property belonging to the parties, except in the ordinary course of business.
4. Plaintiff's attorney shall furnish client with a copy of this Order. The client, upon filing of the Complaint shall be bound by the terms of this Order. The Clerk of this court shall attach to the summons issued thereon a copy of this Order to be served with the summons. The Defendant shall be bound by this Order when served with the summons with a copy of the Order attached. In every instance, the Sheriff or other officer serving such summons shall note in the return the service of a copy of the **Restraining Order** and copy of the **Complaint**. In every such case hereafter filed in which a summons is not served in accordance with above, but in which the Defendant shall be furnished with a copy of this Order, the Defendant shall be thereupon bound by its terms. In cases of waiver, the Clerk is directed not to accept any such waiver unless and until receipt of a copy of the Restraining Order is acknowledged by the Defendant in question.
